



- 1. What is the OFA Internship program? The Opportunities for All Internship program provides an opportunity for local employers to benefit from the attributes of bright, talented, rising future leaders, while providing access to cross-cultural career-oriented experiences for those seeking to broaden their exposure to the professional work world.
- 2. Who is eligible to participate? Graduating Seniors and College students.
- 3. How are interns selected? All potential interns will complete the online application. Once the application is complete, an OFA team member will follow up with an email to schedule a 20–30-minute phone interview.
- 4. What is the purpose of the phone interview? This brief interview will allow the OFA team to get to know you and learn more about your interests, helping us understand your career aspirations to identify potential employers.
- 5. How are interns matched with employers? Interns are matched with employers based on the interests provided on the application along with the formal phone interview.

  - c. Internships begin: Week of June 3, 2024
