

## **YPG Leadership Committee 2018-2019**

### **Co-Chair (or Chair Elect)**

*Term length – 1 year*

- Organizes and oversees strategic objectives for the organization
- Provides direction to the board from the Chamber to further the engagement and retention of YPG members
- Facilitates and presides over board meetings
- Serves as a resource to all other board members and assists board members as needed
- Promotes member engagement in other committees

### **Finance Chair**

*Term length – 1 year*

- The accountant and financial advisor of the Leadership Committee and part of the Sarasota Chamber of Commerce Finance Committee.
- Receives a General Ledger each month and keeps track of our year to date budget.
- Responsible for keeping the YPG Leadership Committee and Chamber of Commerce Finance Committee up to date on our financial situation and for advising the Leadership Committee on where to best focus our efforts to support the budget.
- Promote member engagement in this and other committees.

### **Annual Events Chair**

*Term length – 1 year*

- Works in conjunction with the YPG Programming Chair to lead and facilitate the YPG Events Committee.
- Collaborates with the YPG Leadership Committee and Sarasota Chamber of Commerce to develop logistic strategies for all annual events to execute the annual Events Manifest.
- Serves as a resource to all other committees for securing venues and services for YPG events as needed.
- Promote member engagement in this and other committees.

*Note: This position collaborates with the Programming Chair to oversee and facilitate the “Events Committee”.*

### **Programming Chair**

*Term length – 1 year*

- Works in conjunction with the YPG Annual Events Chair to lead and facilitate the YPG Events Committee.
- Collaborates with the YPG Leadership Committee and Sarasota Chamber of Commerce to develop logistic strategies for After Hours, Pro Dev, and one-off events to execute the Events Manifest.
- Serves as a resource to all other committees for securing venues and services for YPG events as needed.
- Promote member engagement in this and other committees.

*Note: This position collaborates with the Annual Events Chair to oversee and facilitate the “Events Committee”.*

## **Volunteer Chair**

*Term length – 1 year*

- Works with local non-profit organizations to lead and facilitate YPG volunteer opportunities.
- Collaborates with the YPG Leadership Committee and the Community Committee to develop strategies activities for members to provide access and opportunities for further involvement.
- Responsible to other committees for recruiting member volunteer assistance for YPG events as needed.
- Promote member engagement in this and other committees.

*Note: This position collaborates with the Government Issues Chair to oversee and facilitate the “Community Committee”.*

## **Government Issues Chair**

*Term length – 1 year*

- Works with local leaders and city officials (among others) to lead and facilitate the YPG. Government Issues Committee.
- Collaborates with the YPG Leadership Committee and the Community Committee to develop strategies activities for members to provide critical information on issues and opportunities to be heard in Sarasota.
- Serves as a guide and voice on issues surrounding young professionals in Sarasota.
- Promote member engagement in this and other committees.

*Note: This position collaborates with the Volunteer Chair to oversee and facilitate the “Community Committee”.*

## **Membership Chair(s)**

*Term length – 1 year*

- Primary point of contact for members (new and current) looking to get involved in YPG and points them in the right direction.
- Maintains open communications with YPG members to keep a pulse of our overall membership and provides strategic advice to the Leadership Committee.
- Provides membership numbers and investigates reasons for membership loss.
- Develops ways to gain new members and retain current members.
- Responsible for the YPG membership table at After Hours events.
